It's a relaxed and collaborative appointment where we'll talk through your vision, test products, and ensure every detail feels like you.

You'll leave feeling confident and excited — knowing your makeup is one thing you don't have to worry about.

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## When to Book

We recommend booking your trial 3–6 months before your wedding day.

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# What to bring & How to prepare



- Arrive with clean, moisturised skin
- Bring photos of looks you like (Our portfolio is perfect!)
- Wear a white or light top for better colour matching
- Bring your veil, jewellery, or any accessories you'd like to see with your makeup
- Let us know in advance of any skin conditions or allergies
- If your having a hair trial with you hairstylist, its a good idea to book both trials on the same day to see your look come together!
- You are more than welcome to bring one friend or family member to your trial for support.



## After Your Trial

We'll make detailed notes, capture photos, and confirm your look so everything is seamless on the day.

You'll also receive a finalised schedule for your wedding morning, so you know exactly what to expect.



## Bridal Party Trials

Trials for bridesmaids, mums, or other members of your party can be arranged separately.

We recommend this if they're nervous, have skin concerns, or want a specific look.

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# FAQ's

## **Q: Can I try more than one look during my trial?**

Your trial is designed to create your perfect look — we'll refine and tweak until it feels just right. If you're considering two very different styles (e.g. natural vs glam), please let us know in advance so we can allow extra time (additional charges will apply).

## **Q: How long does the trial take?**

We allow up to 2 hours for a bridal trial. This gives us time to consult, apply the look in full, make adjustments, and answer any questions.

## **Q: Can I bring someone with me?**

Of course! You're welcome to one friend or family member for support. Just let us know ahead of time so we can make sure there's space.



# FAQ's

## **Q: What if I change my mind after the trial?**

That's totally fine — sometimes it takes seeing the look to be sure! We're happy to make tweaks or plan a second trial if needed (fees apply). The goal is for you to feel completely confident and excited about your final look.

## **Q: Can I book a trial before committing to a package?**

Our bridal trials are included within our discounted packages and are not offered separately beforehand. This helps us ensure availability and protect your date. If you're unsure which package is right for you, we're happy to guide you through the options — and once you're booked in, your trial becomes a key part of the process.

**Q: I don't usually wear makeup – is a trial still for me?**

Absolutely. Trials are for everyone, and we'll work with you to create a look that feels natural and true to your personal style. You're in safe hands.

**Q: What if I have skin concerns or allergies?**
